Before Election Day

- All stories prepped in Cedar
 - Each story needs: “elex” title, reporter, editor, date/time, photo edits, sections
 - Boilerplate language, photos, tags, components
 - Nick E. will check all stories Nov. 2
- Alerts pre-written: Pushly, email, mobile, website banner
- HP CPs mocked-up: Biden win, Trump win, undecided, unrest
- Components prepped

Election Day

Timeline

- **O’dark Thirty:** Kris begins work on Morning Brief.
- **6 a.m.** Anika begins hub producing shift.
 - Live updates post at 6 a.m.
 - Add HP news banner that says ballots are due at 8 p.m., linking to live updates
- **7:15 a.m.** Morning Brief promotes available election content and lets readers know about live coverage.
- **Around 8 a.m.:** Breaking News alert to live updates story. See news alert plan below.
- **11 a.m.:** Nick S. begins hub producing shift.
- **Noon:** Nick E. and Jeff sign on.
- **3ish p.m.:** Add presidential results widget above CP.
- **3:30 p.m.:** Taylor and Zach begin hub producing shifts.
- **8 p.m.:** Add local results widget. Expect results to drop at any time.
- **ASAP:** First drafts of stories published by line editor via WordPress.
 - **Total of 15** results stories, including Westneat column.

Staffing

Anika -- morning producer

- Homepage, social media, news alerts, assorted other standard tasks
- Work with Nick E. on headline guidance for metro
- Before 7 a.m.: Places HP banner saying ballots are due at 8, linking to live post
- Around 8 a.m.: Sends alert to live post

Nick S. -- dayside producer

- Social media, homepage, news alerts, assorted other tasks
- Makes sure CP'd live thread seems fresh (headline and art)
- Work with Nick E. to help plan CP options in advance.

Jeff -- story-level production, results news alerts

- Coordinate and send news alerts
- Make sure stories are properly built with images, teasers, links and components.
- Fine-tune headlines for SEO and intrigue.
- Communicate with hub producers and Nick about play of stories/headlines on the HP.
- Communicate with Taylor about social media distribution.
- Communicate with Hilary for cross-linking stories and results page.

Taylor -- Social media, Pushly

- Write election news updates Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, LinkedIn as needed
- Listen to social audience for trending topics, news, reactions, conversations
- Share that stuff in #election-night
- Note: Use all caps for "BREAKING" for big results, especially if we call races.
- Socialize non-election content per usual (if there is any)
- Submit links to SpokenLayer -- midnight deadline.

Zach -- Homepage

- Populate zones with published stories.
- Focus on headlines and balance of stories on HP.
- Work with Nick for results-dump rush for changing HP.
- Work with photo eds to keep CP and teaser images up to date.
- Communicate with Emily/Lauren for HP results widget.

Nick E. -- editing and air traffic control

- Work with Zach for results-dump rush for changing HP
- Work with Emily/Lauren on results widget/page.
- Edit news alerts and social posts as needed
- Watch story comments as time allows
- Oversee overall digital presentation
- Overall support with Cedar and WordPress workflow
- Handoff note for AM crew

Lynn -- editorial support

- Editing live updates
- Helping with spinoff posts as needed
- Watch story comments as time allows

Danny -- workflow support

- Overall support with photo, Cedar, WordPress workflow

Emily, Lauren -- interactives

- Manage the results widget.
- Communicate with Nick E. and Zach for homepage placement.

- Don't use "wins" or "loses" until a race is called.
- Use terms like "leading" or "trailing," e.g. "Inslee is leading in Tuesday's returns."
- When necessary, use terms like "seems" or "appears" to couch the info.

Note: High bar for non-election alerts.

7:15 a.m. Morning Brief: Roundup of election stuff

8 a.m.: Breaking News alert to the live-updates post

10 a.m.: Don't Miss alert to interactive about what's at stake in this election.

Afternoon: Don't Miss alert to the live post, saying we'll have results after 8.

5:30 p.m. Evening Brief: Lead with live thread and fresh photo.

Evening: Breaking News alert on presidential race so far, and additional alerts as needed.

- Lindsay Graham, Mitch McConnell, other movement in the Senate
- key moments throughout the day, like Florida or Pennsylvania results

Results drop (8ish p.m.): Breaking news alerts on local results for:

- Presidential race
- Governor race
- Additional local races: transit tax, sex ed

Later evening: Don't Miss alert for Danny Westneat's column.

- “primary election results”
- “Washington state”
- candidates’ full names (i.e. *Jay Inslee*, not just *Inslee*)
- name of position they’re running for (i.e. *superintendent*, not *chief*)

These are super important; a full 1/3 of our subscription starts come via web search results. Also, please remember to write summaries, which should be 200-250 characters long. Thanks so much!
